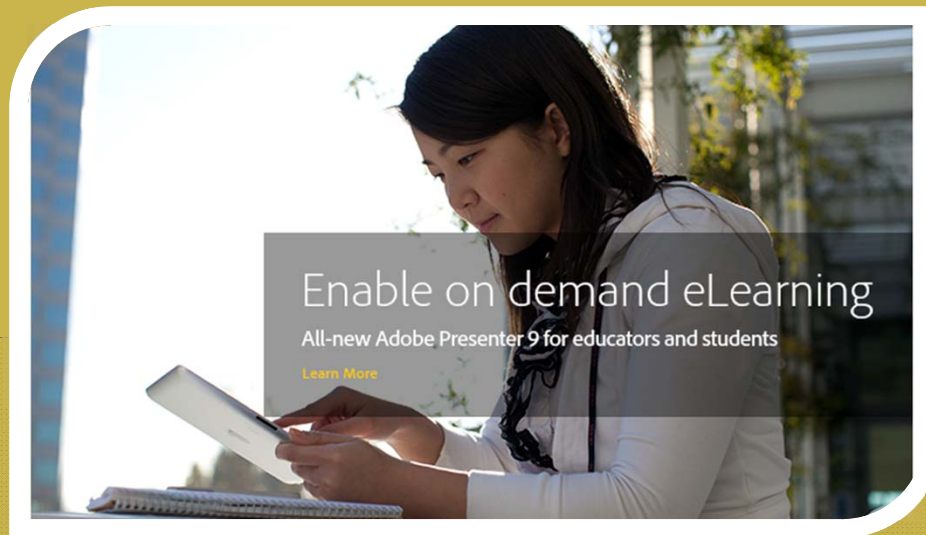

Why Adobe Presenter?

- interface/simple to use
 - attach documents
 - differentiation
 - notes
- post/ask and answer questions
- monitoring students/intervention
 - scorm/email
 - upload to your own servers
- give the students content on a memory stick
