Dear Judge Sorokin:

I write regarding the pending motion to enforce judgment, or in the alternative, to intervene, Dkt. No. 115, in light of the filing of the Stipulation of Dismissal, Dkt. No. 131.

First, nothing in the Stipulation of Dismissal calls into question the evidence that Plaintiffs previously submitted in their response to the Commonwealth's motion, Dkt. No. 123 at 7–8. In their response, Plaintiffs provided clear evidence that Defendant continues to engage in involuntary collection from students listed on Exhibit 4 of the defense to repayment application submitted by Attorney General Healey to the Secretary dated November 30, 2015 (the "DTR").

Second, since filing its motion, the Commonwealth has obtained additional evidence that Defendant continues to involuntarily collect from students listed in Exhibit 4. For instance, a former Corinthian student listed in Exhibit 4 to the DTR had her tax refund seized on April 24, 2019. This evidence, together with evidence submitted by Plaintiffs, shows that Defendant continues to disregard the DTR and this Court's Order dated October 24, 2018, Dkt. No. 99. *See* Exhibit A, Tax Offset Notice; Exhibit B, Notice of Default.

Thank you for the Court's consideration of this additional information.
