

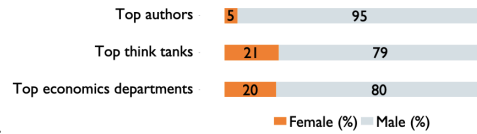
# WiE Index 2020

The WiE Index monitors and records the share of women economists in senior positions in the academic, private, and public sectors.

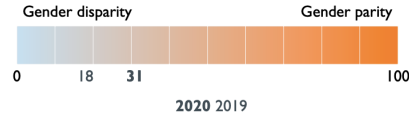
It consists of three pillars with each constituting different indicators.

3. Faculty members of top economic departments

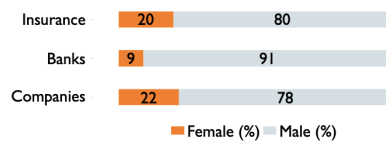


WiE Index Academic Pillar

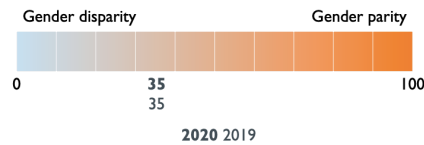


## Private Sector

3. Large companies

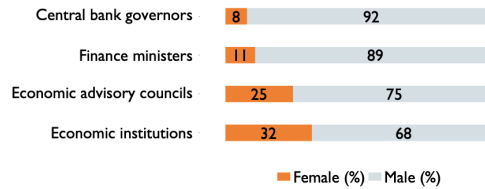


WiE Index Private Sector Pillar

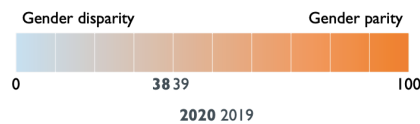


## Public Sector

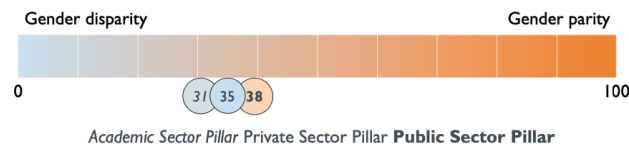
1. Governors of central banks

4. Chief economists of international economic institutions



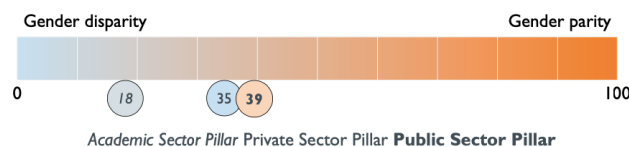
WiE Index Public Sector Pillar
