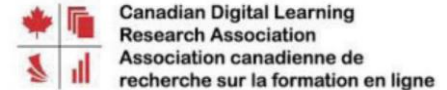

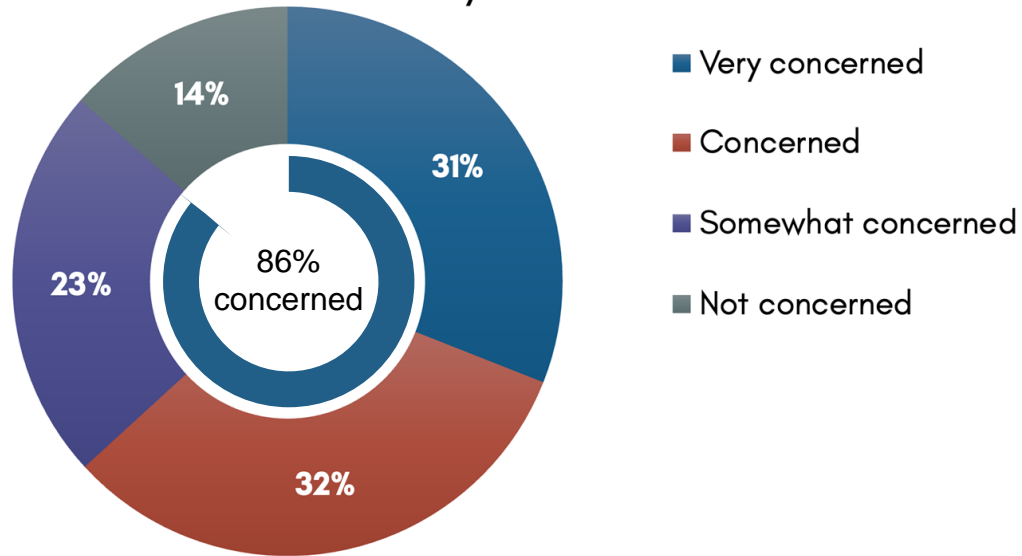


Enrollment Concerns

College Administrator: *“We are seeing declining enrollments and have tried to combat it with more online education and by admitting more students.”*

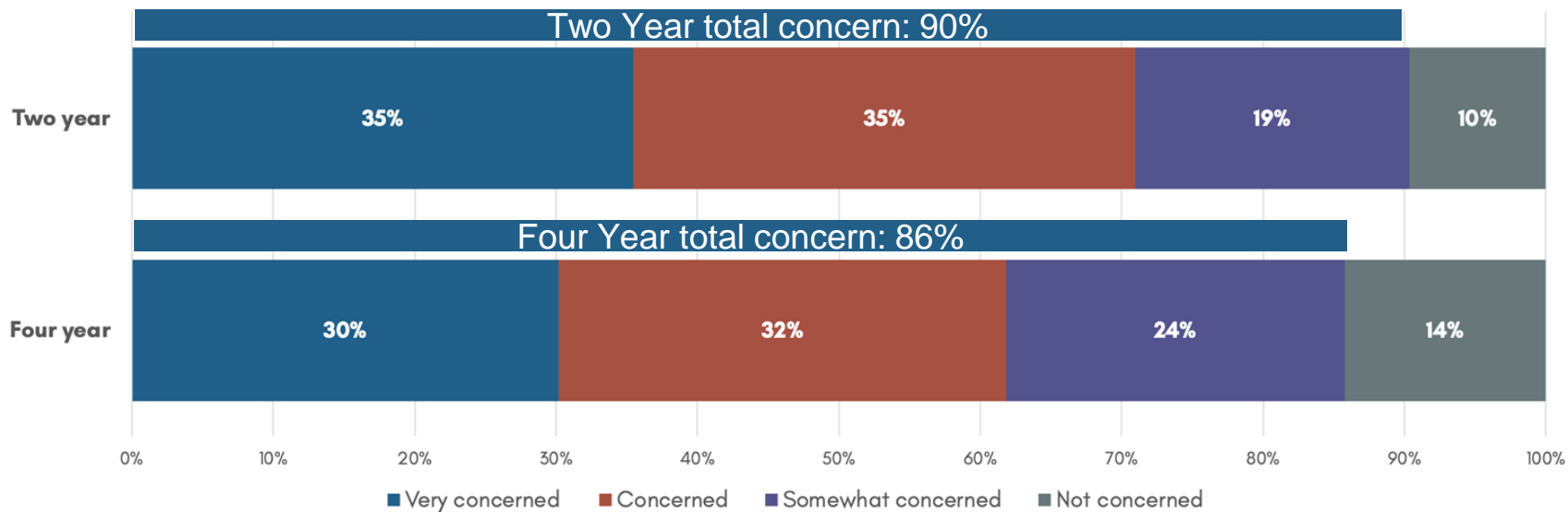
ALMOST EVERYONE IS CONCERNED ABOUT ENROLLMENTS

How concerned are you about the level of future enrollments at your institution?



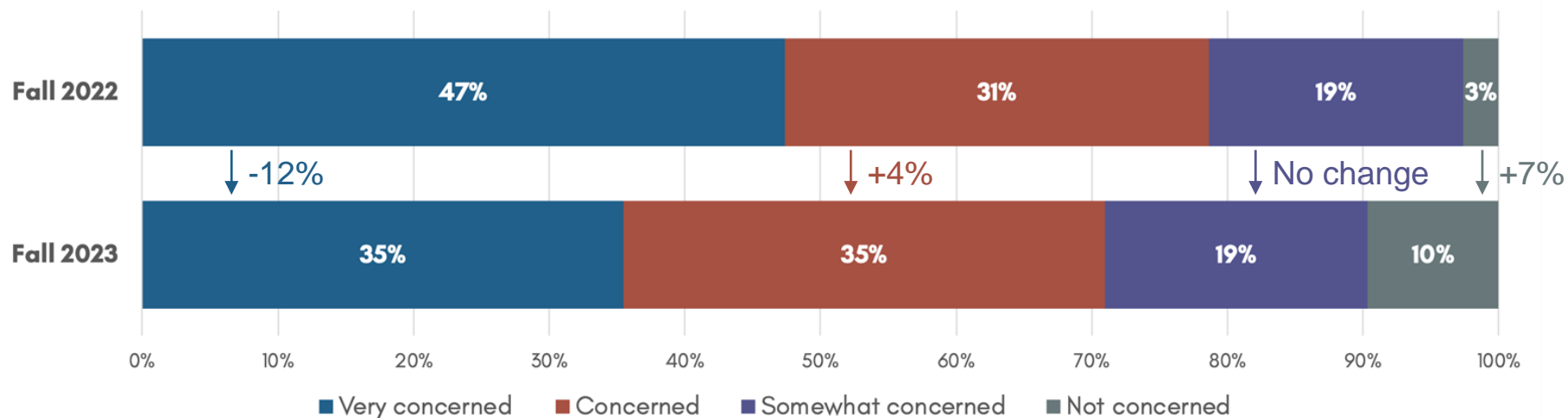
GREATEST CONCERN AT TWO-YEAR INSTITUTIONS

Two-year Institutions: How concerned are you about the level of future enrollments at your institution?

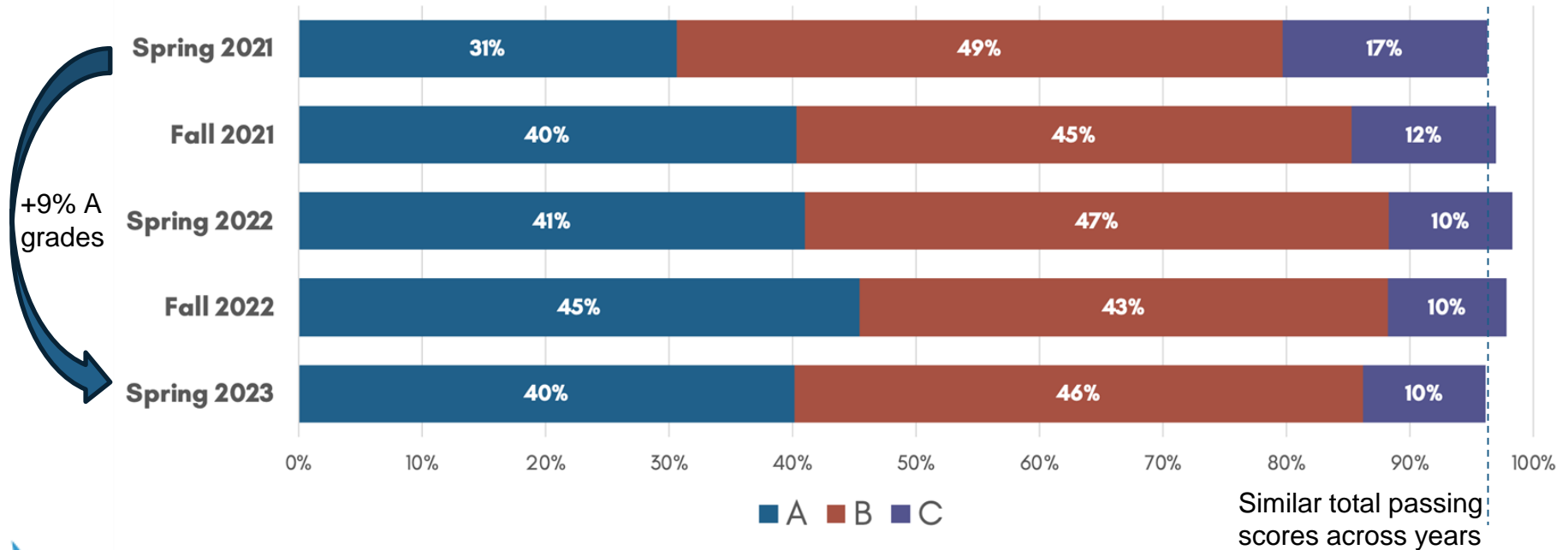




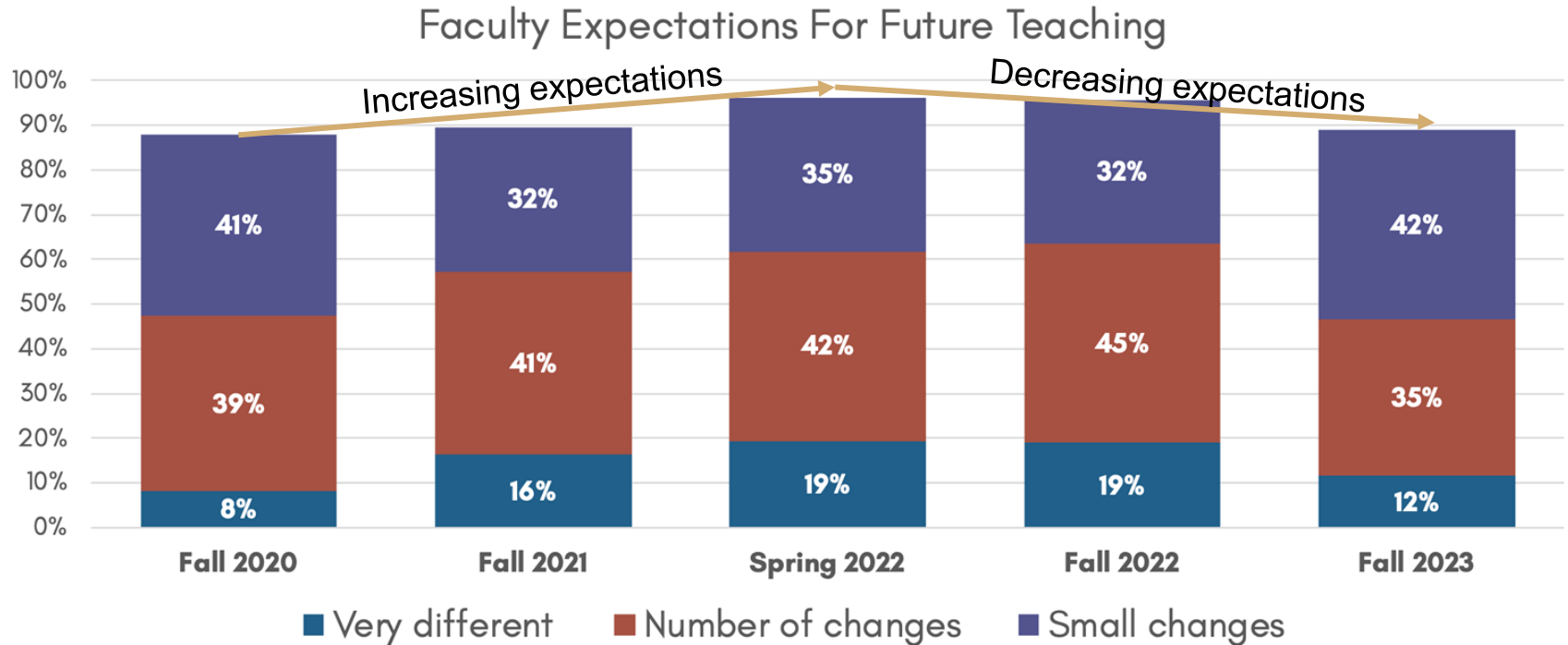
Growth of Digital Learning

VIRTUALLY ALL FACULTY EXPECT CHANGES



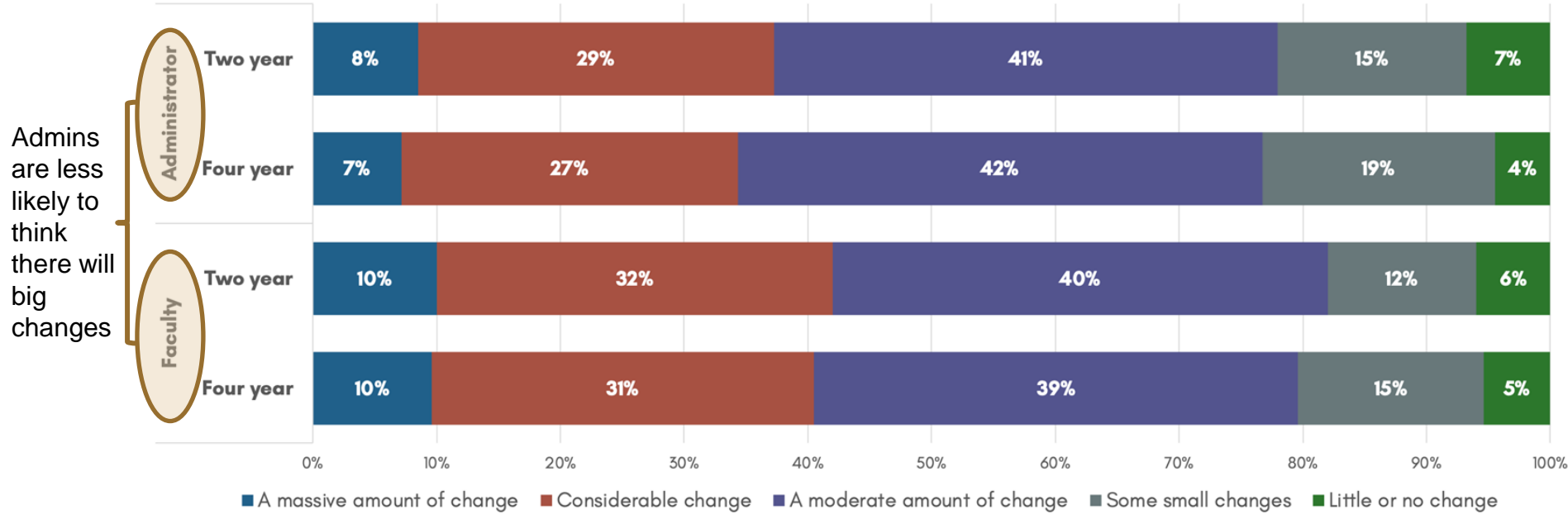


The Impact of AI

How much will Artificial Intelligence (AI) tools change your institution over the next five years?

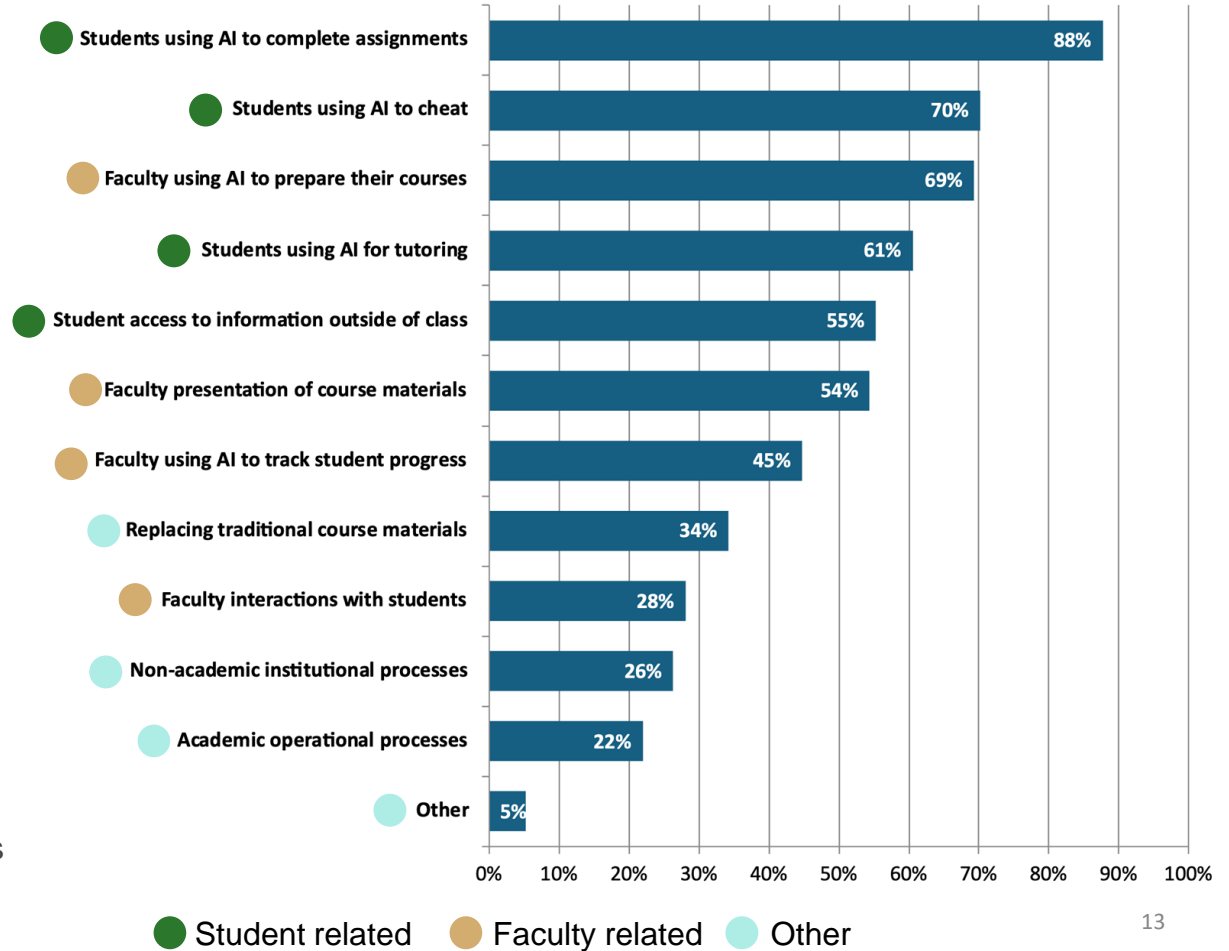


AI EXPECTED TO IMPACT MULTIPLE AREAS

What areas of your institution do you expect AI to change?

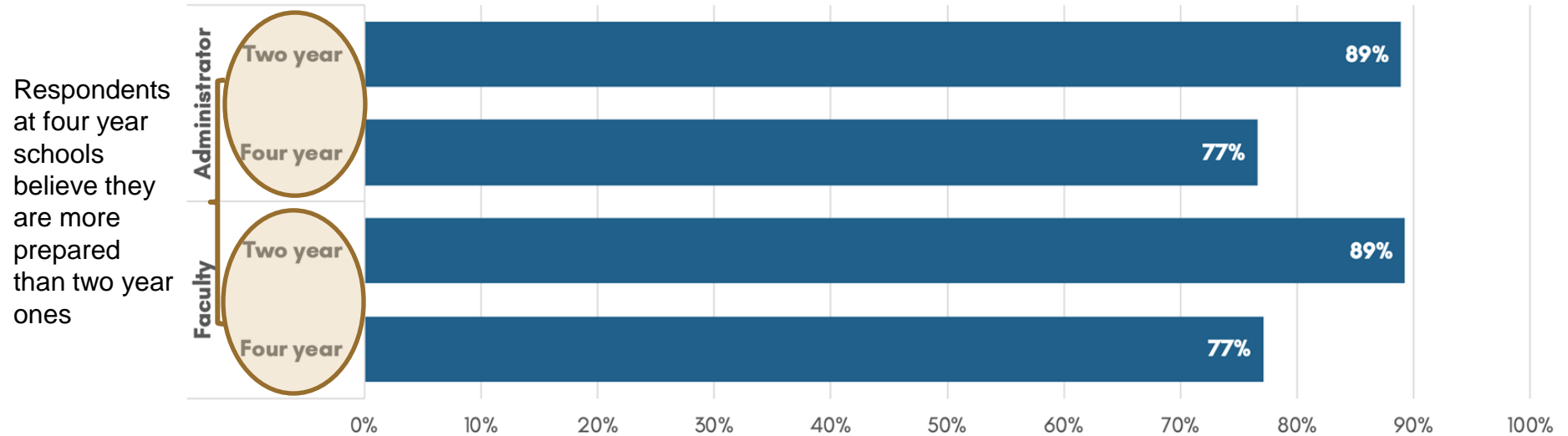

Student: *“My institution is incredibly expensive and it makes it hard to justify the cost.”*

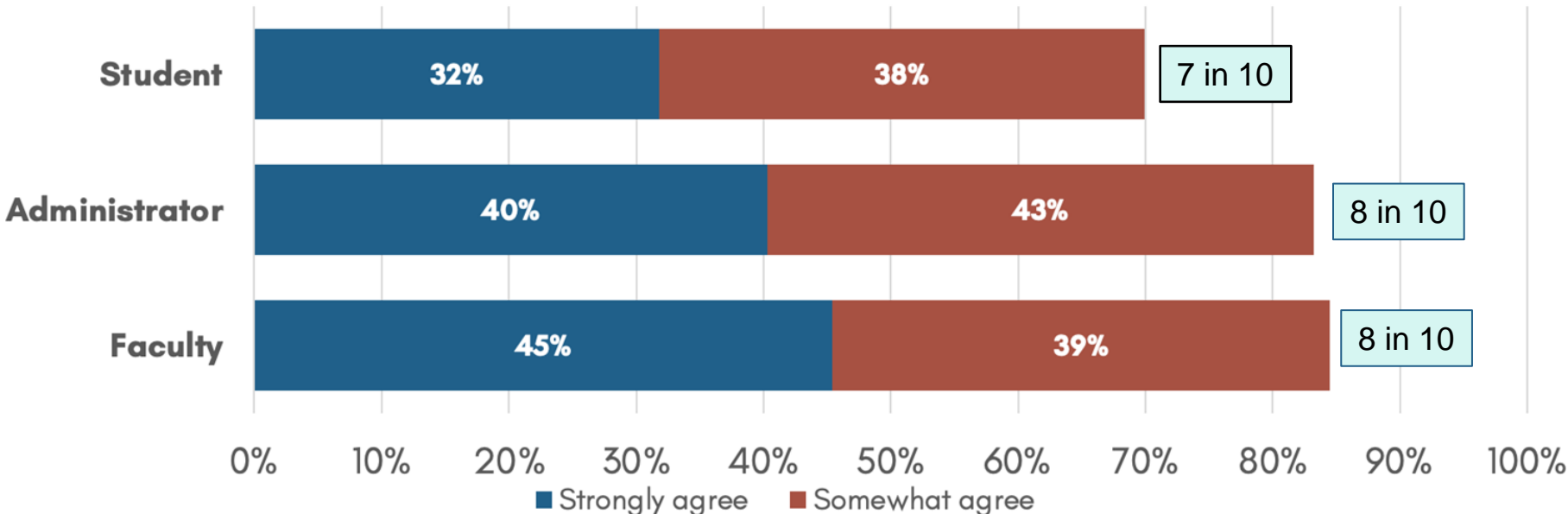
Cost

“Very challenging and stressful with no forgiveness”

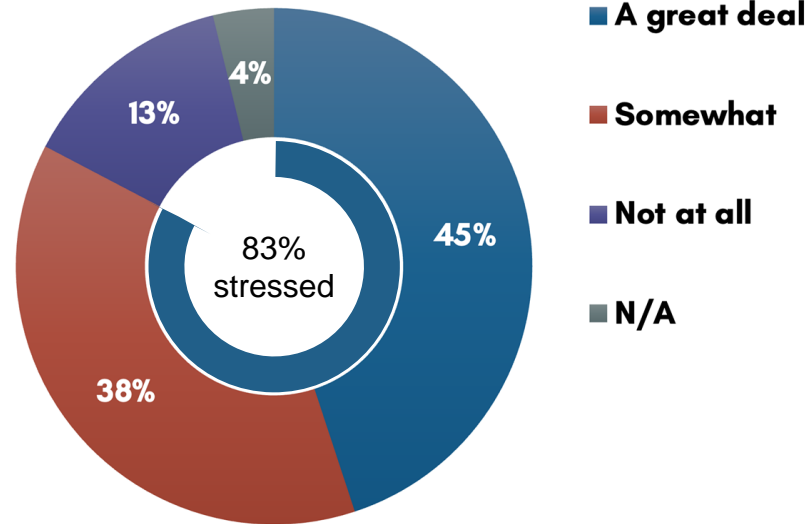
Student Stress

“I work very hard to be a high achieving student but find that my stress levels are far too high for what I get out of them.”



STRESS IS A MAJOR BARRIER FOR STUDENTS

To what degree are feelings of stress a problem for you?

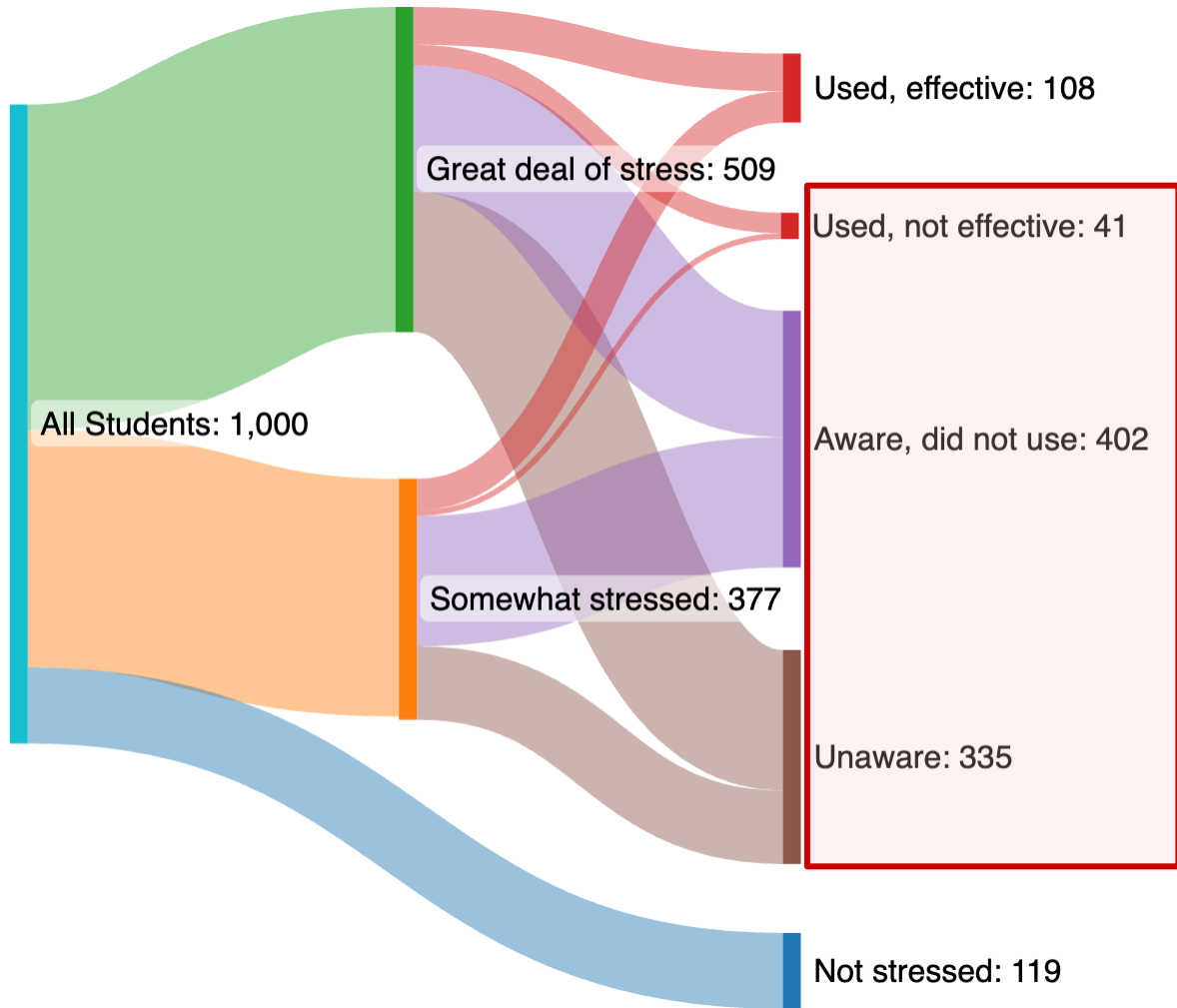


Students cite stress as their most pressing barrier, with a major reporting that they are suffering a “Great deal of stress.”

A third of students are unaware of any institutional supports.

Forty percent are aware but chose not to use the supports.

The small portion using the services generally find them to be effective.
