RE: Ineligible Additional Locations

Dear President Imhoff:

From November 15, 2010 through November 18, 2010, Mr. Roy Chaney, Ms. Lisa Hoskins, and Ms. Kathy Feith as representatives of the U.S. Department of Education (Department) conducted a review of Mid-Continent University's (MCU) administration of the Federal student financial aid programs authorized pursuant to Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended, 20 U.S.C. §§ 1070 et seq. (Title IV, HEA programs). As part of the program review, the reviewers discovered that MCU improperly received Title IV, HEA funds in the name of students attending locations (See Attachment) that offers 50% or more of an eligible program, and that the institution failed to report the additional location to the Department. See 34 C.F.R. § 600.21(d).

These locations have received neither approval from MCU's accrediting agency nor approval from the applicable state authorizing agency. See id. In reviewing accreditation approvals from Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS), MCU was approved to only offer less than 50% of a program at the additional sites. As a result, MCU must immediately cease disbursing Title IV, HEA funds to students at these unreported, unlicensed, and unaccredited locations. See id. See also 34 C.F.R. § 600.21(a)(3).

The Department considers MCU's failure to report the additional unlicensed and unaccredited locations, prior to receiving Title IV, HEA funds, to be a serious violation. See 34 C.F.R. § 600.21(e). The Department is seriously considering changing the method in which MCU will receive Title IV, HEA funds. The Department will notify MCU of its decision in writing under separate cover.

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As a result of this violation, to secure Title IV, HEA eligibility for these additional locations, MCU must: 1) obtain approval of the location from MCU's accrediting agency and applicable state authorizing agency; 2) submit to the Department an application, including all documentation required by that application, using the Department's "Application for Approval to Participate in the Federal Student Financial Aid Programs", then wait for the Department's approval for the additional locations. MCU must apply and wait for the Department's approval for any future additional locations that MCU wishes to make Title IV, HEA eligible. 34 C.F.R. § 600.20(c)(1)(v).

Further, when MCU applies to the Department for recertification of its Title IV, HEA eligibility, the Department has the authority under 34 C.F.R. § 668.13 to certify MCU's eligibility to participate on a provisional basis as a result of its failure to meet the requirements under 34 C.F.R. § 600.21(a) (3).

All Title IV, HEA funds that MCU received at the unreported unlicensed, and unaccredited locations are liabilities that must be repaid to the Department. 34 C.F.R. § 600.21(e). The Department will provide payment instructions and any additional instructions to MCU in a subsequent Final Program Review Determination (FPRD) letter.

The institution must provide a spreadsheet by award year for all Title IV, HEA funds disbursed at the ineligible locations. The following information for each student must be provided:

• First and last name;

Last four digits of the student's social security number;

Date and amount of each Title IV disbursement, by Title IV program;

• Date and amount of any Return of Title IV Funds calculation performed, by Title IV program;

• Amount of Title IV funds returned, if applicable (organized by Title IV program, then by date of return, then by amount

Protection of Personally Identifiable Information

PROTECTION OF PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE INFORMATION

Personally Identifiable Information (PII) being submitted to the Department must be protected. PII is any information about an individual which can be used to distinguish or trace an individual's identity (some examples are name, social security number, date and place of birth).

PII being submitted electronically or on media (e.g., CD-ROM, floppy disk, DVD) must be encrypted. The data must be submitted in a .zip file encrypted with Advanced Encryption Standard (AES) encryption (256-bit is preferred). The Department uses WinZip. However, files created with other encryption software are also acceptable, provided that they are compatible with WinZip (Version 9.0) and are encrypted with AES encryption. Zipped files using WinZip must be saved as Legacy compression (Zip 2.0 compatible).

The Department must receive an access password to view the encrypted information. The password must be e-mailed separately from the encrypted data. The password must be 12 characters in length and use three of the following: upper case letter, lower case letter, number, special character. A manifest must be included with the e-mail that lists the types of files being sent (a copy of the manifest must be retained by the sender).

Hard copy files and media containing PII must be:

 sent via a shipping method that can be tracked with signature required upon delivery

double packaged in packaging that is approved by the shipping agent (FedEx, DHL, UPS, USPS)

- labeled with both the "To" and "From" addresses on both the inner and outer packages

- identified by a manifest included in the inner package that lists the types of files in the shipment (a copy of the manifest must be retained by the sender).

PII data cannot be sent via fax.
