New British-licensed med-school in Turks and Caicos admitting U.S. and E.U. students in 2014 invites expressions of partnership interest by U.S. universities. Graduates will practice primary care medicine in U.S and E.U.

Innovative Equity Partnership Model for Emerging School of Medicine Responds to Projected Need for Primary Care Physicians in USA.

The newly emerging medical school will begin accepting students from the U.S. and E.U. and Caribbean in 2014. It has received Initial Provisional Accreditation for the awarding of the M.D. degree by the Caribbean Accreditation Authority for Education in Medicine and other Health Professions (CAAM-HP) and will also offer M.P.H. and Dr.P.H. degree programs. Graduates will fill the projected need for primary care physicians in the U.S.

Partnership discussions include the naming of the medical school, an initial 20 percent investment with eventual opportunity to increase control to 51 percent and then to 90 percent.

Of particular interest to universities with PA, NP programs is the opportunity it provides graduates of those programs to apply to advanced standing in med-school.
