

CICan member colleges and institutes across Canada:


 Over 95% of Canadians and over 86% of Indigenous people in Canada live within 50km or a college or institute location.

How do we build partnerships?


 By linking Canadian institutions with partners around the world, we help transform postsecondary education and connect learners with employment-based training and global skills they need to succeed.

The Sustainable Development Goals give us a model for collaboration to create positive change.




