- **1265** 4-year universities & colleges
- **1423** 3-year higher vocational colleges
- **30,315,262** students in 3-4 year colleges
- **2,863,712** in master/doctoral programs
- **2,602,793** faculty & staff
- **317,299** Chinese students studying in U.S. institutions during 2020-21



Chinese-foreign joint institutes and programs (offshore campus or programs)

- **185** Chinese-foreign joint institutes and **1,248** joint programs at bachelor degree level or above approved
- **50** institutes and **1,034** programs at higher vocational level approved
