
About VCU Medical School

74 percent of Duke employees wanted to continue some kind of remote or hybrid work.²





What is HyFlex?

Hybrid flexible (HyFlex) combines face-to-face and online learning.

Each class session is offered in-person, synchronously online, and asynchronously online. Students can decide—for each class or activity—how to participate.



The result is "a student-directed, multi-modal learning experience."


Student Engagement

- What is the student's responsibility of being an online learner?




Faculty Support & Development

According to Sallie Mae's recent How America Pays for College report, compared with White students, **Black and Hispanic students are more likely to find online learning effective.**




68 percent of Black respondents felt positive about online learning.



60 percent of Hispanic respondents rated online learning positively.


Institutional Leadership
