


SUNY Oswego Focuses on Getting Students, Not Applicants

Getting Ready for Post-Affirmative Action World

- Emphasize class, not race and ethnicity.
- Using geography (creatively).
- 10% plans (in some cases).



Direct Admissions

- It's taken off among colleges that are not competitive in admissions.
- This is the first year in which it is fully in place (with several hundred colleges, several companies, etc.).
- While those participating are giving direct admissions rave reviews, others are skeptical.
