

RESOLUTION
of the
COLLEGE CONGRESS
THREE RIVERS COMMUNITY COLLEGE

WHEREAS, the controversial Connecticut Community College consolidation plan failed to receive approval of the NEASC accreditors, and

WHEREAS, the failure to obtain approval is the latest event in a history of failures in funding, planning and leadership, particularly since the Community Colleges merged with the universities under a single Board of Regents,

NOW THEREFORE, and in consideration of the foregoing the College Congress of Three Rivers Community College resolves as follows:

“BE IT RESOLVED, that the College Congress joins with their colleagues at other state colleges and universities in expressing their dissatisfaction with the lack of effective leadership and direction of the current CSCU President and Board of Regents; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the College Congress strongly encourages the State Legislature to take immediate steps to correct both the fiscal shortfalls and organizational ineffectiveness that have hampered publicly funded post-secondary education, particularly since the creation of a single Board of Regents.”
